1. Report on Educational Tour for Economic Survey of Women in Sona Khann Village session 2023-24

Organized By: Government C.L.C. College, Patan, District Durg Course: Master of Social Work (MSW) Venue: Sona Khann Village, Baloda Bazar District Supported By: NGO Samarthan Date: 04-03-2024 to 10-03-2024

Introduction

As part of the Master of Social Work curriculum, students of Government C.L.C. College, Patan, undertook an educational tour to Sona Khann village in Baloda Bazar district. The primary objective of the visit was to conduct an economic survey of women in the village to understand their livelihood patterns, socio-economic challenges, and access to resources. The survey was facilitated by **NGO Samarthan**, which works towards empowering marginalized communities through sustainable development practices.

Objectives

- 1. To understand the economic status of women in the rural setting of Sona Khann village.
- 2. To analyze the socio-economic challenges faced by women, including employment, income generation, and resource accessibility.
- 3. To engage with the community and understand the role of NGOs like Samarthan in rural development.
- 4. To provide practical exposure to students in conducting field surveys and data collection.

Activities Undertaken

5. Orientation Session:

• NGO Samarthan conducted an orientation program to familiarize students with the village's socio-economic background, cultural practices, and the methodologies to be employed for the survey.

6. Economic Survey:

- The survey covered approximately [insert number] households in Sona Khann village.

Key Findings

9. Economic Challenges:

- A significant portion of women in the village were engaged in informal or agricultural labor, with limited access to stable income sources.
- Lack of awareness and accessibility to government schemes was observed.

10. Social Dynamics:

• Traditional gender roles continued to restrict women's participation in decision-making and leadership roles.

11. Opportunities for Development:

• Women expressed interest in skill-based training programs to enhance their employability.

• Existing SHGs supported by Samarthan had shown promising results in boosting economic independence.

Learning Outcomes

- Students gained practical experience in conducting field surveys and interacting with rural communities.
- The activity provided insights into grassroots-level socio-economic issues and the impact of development initiatives.
- The role of NGOs like Samarthan in empowering rural women was critically understood.

Conclusion and Recommendations

The educational tour was a valuable learning experience for the MSW students, bridging theoretical knowledge with real-world application. It highlighted the pressing need for:


- 15. Enhanced awareness programs to educate women about their rights and available government schemes.
