TITLE OF THE PRACTICE:

"Vidyadan Yojna" (Donation of Education)

OBJECTIVES OF THE PRACTICE:

- 1. To spread education in rural areas through the help of the college students.
- 2. To make the students aware about the challenges in school education.
- 3. To extend the services to the school education by the students of the college.
- 4. To help the students of the schools to get education in case of the lack of teachers in their schools. To develop the personality of college students through the goodwill services in the field of education.
- 5. To help the school students in the remedial classes.

THE CONTEXT:

The college has been conducting this activity since last five years. It has been highly effective practice. The college is situated in the subdivision area. There are many schools in the nearby villages where there are vacancies of teachers. The students of the institute go to the Sarpanch of the concerned school and with the help of the Sarpanch, the student of the college offers their help in teaching the students of the concerned school. Sometimes the students of the college extend their help through conducting the remedial classes also for the school students in the subjects they need some extra academic help. This practice is of great help for the students who were not able to afford costly private tuition and online classes. The students extended their contribution in the teaching-learning process as per the demands of the Head Master or the teachers of the concerned school also. In this project, the volunteer students aim at developing the personality of the students of the concerned schools. The volunteer conducts separate classes as well as Mohalla (colony) classes as per the need of the school students.

THE PRACTICE:


The volunteer student decided to select to teach the school students for their Vidyadan Project. For this purpose, he meets with the school authority as well as the concerned Sarpanch of the Gram (village) Panchayat. The volunteer teaches in their leisure. Usually, the volunteer teaches the classes where there is no teacher posted. They teach the subjects of which teacher is not posted in the concerned school. They teach the portion of a subject in which a school student faced any problem to understand. EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS: The Volunteer students are conferred with the certificate after completing the project. The record of the total project is kept by the incharge teacher of the institute. The photographs taken during the activities are also kept by the incharge teacher. All the activities are properly reported to the incharge teacher. The progress report is analysed by the committee running the project. The volunteers bring certificate of work done from the concerned authorities of their concerned school.

PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED AND RESOURCES REQUIRED: 0517 HEIGENORY VICE, GT (8.71)

There are a number of problems that the volunteers encounter during the project. They face problems in the selection of the schools that needs their help most. Sometimes they don't get expected cooperation from the concerned schools, but they always solve the problem using their positive personality skills. Sometimes they encounter problems when the school students don't cooperate properly in the teaching-learning process. In this

regard also, the volunteer students motivate the concerned students and solve the problem. There is a problem regarding the time schedules to teach.

The volunteers manage timing as per their leisure and the comfort of the concerned. Most of the problems are easily solved with the cooperation of parents of the student and the Sarpanch of the concerned area. The school management also comes forward to extend their cooperation.



Report on MSW Students' Participation in Vidya Daan Yojna

Title: Active Engagement of MSW Students in Vidya Daan Yojna

Introduction:

The Vidya Daan Yojna is an initiative aimed at enhancing educational opportunities for primary school students by engaging community resources. As part of this program, 40 Master of Social Work (MSW) students from GOVT. C.L.C ARTS AND SCIENCE PG COLLEGE (PATAN) participated by teaching in primary schools located near their respective localities. This report highlights the efforts, experiences, and outcomes of this commendable activity.

Objective:

The primary objective of this initiative was to contribute to the holistic development of primary school students through academic support and foster a sense of social responsibility among MSW students.

Program Overview:

• **Duration:** 7 days

• Time Commitment: 3 hours per day

OBJECTIVES OF THE PRACTICE:

- 2. To spread health awareness in the society.
- 3. To instill in the students of the institute the spirit of service to the mankind.
- 4. To help the health workers time-to-time.
- 5. To contribute in the health-related programmes organized by the different departments of the government.

THE CONTEXT:

The institute understands its social duties and obligations, so it conducts various projects that do social services to society and to the mankind. The institute conducts a "Health Awareness Project". The students of the institute participate in many health-related programmes. The institute has a Youth Red Cross Unit. The institute organizes health camps. The students of the institute spread awareness in their villages also. They report the activities to the in-charge teacher of the project. The NSS Cadets of the college also plan and execute health related activities in the villages that adopted for the NSS activities. The record of all the activities under the project was kept by the in charge teacher. The photographs of the health related programmes are also kept by the in-charge teacher. Whenever any special activity is organized by the institute, a team of staff members conduct all the activities. The institute keeps on conducting the health awareness programmes under the project. The institute has Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Patan Hospital. Sometimes whenever the hospital authority needs the help of the students of the institute, the students participate in the health related programmes organized by the Patan Hospital.

THE PRACTICE:

With regard to the health issues, our aim is to keep continuous practice to create an awareness in the stakeholders to be health aware citizens. There are diseases like anemia, sickle cell, stomach worm, leprosy etc. that affect the areas near the institute. The institute organizes activities like awareness rallies, wall slogan writing, essay competition, quiz competition to create awareness about keeping good health. The YRC unit of the institute organizes general health check-up camp, anti-worm tablet distribution camp, blood-group checking camp, nutrition awareness programs, leprosy awareness

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programmes etc. The red-ribbon, the blue-brigade and the NSS units of the institute organize invited lectures also to create awareness about many health-related issues.
