(1) Suggestions Received from Alumini and Action Taken Report

(a) Alumni meeting is organised in the college, and the suggestions for development of college is received by the alumni committee.

(b) a WhatsApp group is formed for continuous attachment and connection with college aluminies.

(c) Invited guest lecture is proposed to deliver lecture from aluminies. It is a good suggestion.

(d) The career counselling cell is constituted in the college. A memorandum of understanding (MoU) has been done for the guidance and placement of students. The lectures on preparation of various competition exams are organised by the college inviting some external experts. Besides, NET/SET e...

Report: (3) Students Suggestion About College and Action Taken

(a) Sports teacher is on deputation. This was done by government order. The incharge sports teacher organizes events for students. Sports assistant post was filled in the current session, according to Government rule.

(b) cycle stand is prepared between the building and under- construction science block building. As soon as the science block building will be prepared and handover, the cycle stand will be well furnished day place for parking.

(c) Lessons were taught through ICT medium, whenever needed. The projector are available in the classrooms. The students presented their Power-Point presentation. The links of YouTube are sent to students through WhatsApp group. Online classes were organised in many departments, like in Mathematics.

(d) Travel and tourism, experiments in laboratory, full feeling the lab- equipments and the Chemicals, etc. are important parts of education. These curricular activities are based on syllabus. The Chemicals are bought through government rule.

(e) nearly 26000 books in library are sufficient reference books are also available text books are purchased according to syllabus the students may issue all the books and reference books in a state of newly purchased books. Books never become old, but their contents, matching with syllabus maybe read. Students can prepare their notes through sitting in library. The issuing of books of all new editions for all the admitted students are not possible.

(f) PGDCA, DCA and BCA are computer related programs available in the college. The practical work is done after theory classes. Two posts of Assistant Professors are sanctioned from

government. One lab instructor post is appointed by JBS for lab work.

(g) Technical and skill-based courses are provided in the new education policy-2020. Any student can opt (select) these courses from a pool of GE (General Elective), VAC (valued-added course) and SEC (Skill Enhancement Course) syllabus, what they want to study. There are no restrictions to opt (select) the interdisciplinary courses. Many Arts stream student has chosen the Computer and Science related course, while many Science- stream students has selected Arts and Commerce- related courses.

(g) Table, Furniture, Fan, Parking, Canteen, availability of sports-material etc. are the maintenance related issues. This will be managed and maintained according to necessity of students.

4) Teacher Feedback and Action Taken Report:

(a) For skill development of students, the New Education Policy -2020 has sufficient provisions in the UG (undergraduate II-nd semester) syllabus, the college has started many SEC (skill enhancement courses), e. g.

(i) Gardening and Floriculture by Botany Department.

(ii) citizenship duty and e- Governance by Department of Political Science

(iii) Ethics, Politics and Skill in social research- by Department of Sociology.

(iv) संप्रेशन कला एवं सर्जनात्मक हिंदी (Sampreshan Kala Avm sarjanatmak Hindi) by the Department of Hindi

(v) Principle of Map making- by the Department of Geography.

Besides many value added courses prepare students for their bright future for example

(i) AI

(ii) basic mathematics and logic.

courses are designed by nep 2020, and introduced for undergraduate semester- 1 semester -2 students.

(b) Educational tour- This is an extra-curricular activity, and a part of the syllabus. Similarly, Field work, Survey, Project work preparation, Social survey, etc. are done in the MSW (Master of Social Work), and Sociology and Political science departments.

(c) Teaching through projector by using the ICT based learning is available in the college. The student presents their lesson through the use of ICT. Some department like PGDCA, Zoology and MSW regularly organise classes, when needed. Other departments organize the parallel way of teaching like GD (Group Discussion), Debate, essay writing, Notes preparation method, sending of YouTube link, Unit-Test, BBP (Black Board Presentation) as a part of teaching.

(d) Regular teachers will be appointed by the Government order.

(e) NSS, sports and Red Cross units are functional in the college. These units take students for their programs on regular basis. NSS camp, blood donation camp, free health checkup camp, career counselling programs etc. were organised by related Departments.

Besides, many programs like debate competition, group discussion, essay writing, speech competition, Rangoli making competition, Human chain making, Campus cleanliness activities, Cycle rally, Social and Economic survey, many Awareness events, Cultural activities, and Lectures are also arranged in the college. The students need to take part in all the events and activities.














5) SSS (Student Satisfaction Survey) and Action Taken Report:
