

Students' Union in College

There is a Students' Union in all college. Every year the college constructs the Student Union according to University's instruction and rules. Principal is the patron of this union. Also, a senior professor takes charge as a student union in-charge. The members of this union are nominated through merit basis. The Students Union consists of (a) students' council (b) class representative. They take oath from the principal after constitution.

The aims and objectives of the students' union are

to promote and reinforce the democratic values and principles amongst the students and to educate them about their duties and rights in democracy.

to provide them with responsibilities to emerge with value oriented leadership qualities.

to promote respect for human rights and dignity to the individuals and to eliminate ragging.

to promote intellectual, social and cultural activities in the campuses to induce discipline in the academic institutions.

to enhance participation in literary, cultural, artistic, innovative and sports activities to bring out their leadership and creative talents.

to promote scientific study and discussion on subjects of national and international importance.

to extend social service through mutual cooperation. This will be a step towards shaping a generation dedicated towards social, economic, political issues of the society as envisaged in the Indian Constitution.

to nurture an atmosphere of learning and teaching for the development of the college. (ix) to infuse the ideals of Red-cross Society among the student.
