**2.1.2- Average percentage of seats filled against seats reserved for various categories (SC, ST, OBC, Divyangjan, etc. as per applicable reservation policy during the last five years (exclusive of supernumerary seats))**

**Exclusive of supernumerary seats**

According to the admission rule of Chhattisgarh Government, SC-12%, ST-32%, OBC-14%. So this total percent of admission is 58%. Hence, the un-served (UR) seats for admission is 42%. Out of these admission percent, one third seats is horizontally reserved for the girl students. Since the number of boys candidate for admission is not more than two third of total seats, therefore most of the girls candidate got admission in the non-reserved seats against boys category . It clarifies that most of the students are girls.

Similarly, there is not more than 42% un-reserved category students. Therefore, in the UR (unreserved) seats of candidates, the reserved students get admission. The admission strictly follows the merit rule. Hence in the UR (general) category, the reserved candidate got admission.
